**Non-Freezing Cold Injury - Immersion Foot**

Immersion foot is a local, non-freezing injury that occurs in cold, wet conditions, usually in temperatures of 30° to 40°F The injury occurs when blood vessels constrict in response to heat loss, reducing blood flow to the extremity and depriving cells of oxygen and nutrients Nerves are especially sensitive
